ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINE

A. General Information

1. These guidelines apply to all presenters in the Oral Presentation session.
2. Only abstracts that pass the scientific review process are eligible for oral presentation.
3. The conference committee reserves the right to make adjustments to the program schedule if necessary.
4. Presenters are required to be available prior to the start of the session, as follows:
 - a. Onsite presenters are required to arrive at the assigned presentation room before the presentation session begins.
 - b. Online presenters are required to join the assigned Zoom session before the presentation session begins.
5. The official language of the conference is English.

B. Presentation Format

1. Oral presentations will be conducted in parallel panel sessions.
2. Each presenter will be allocated 10 minutes for the presentation. The presentations will be conducted in a panel format, with the question-and-answer session held at the end of the panel session.
3. Presenters are strongly encouraged to keep within the allocated time.
4. Moderators may stop presentations exceeding the allotted time.

C. Presentation Structure

To maximize clarity and effectiveness, presenters are encouraged to organize their presentation as follows:

1) Introduction

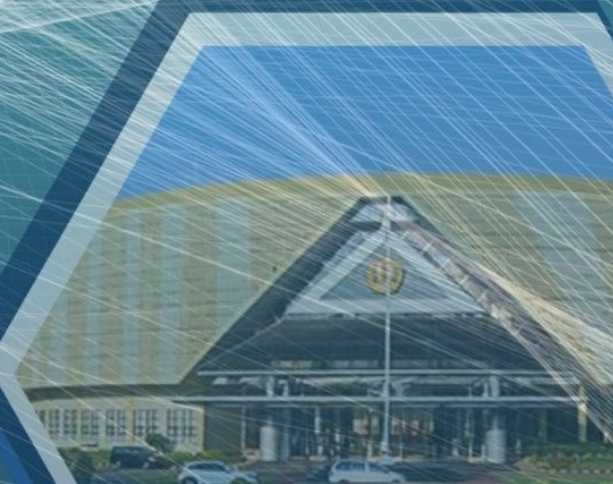
- Brief self-introduction
- Presentation title and objectives
- Importance/significance of the study

2) Background and Context

- Brief overview of the problem
- Current evidence or previous studies
- Research gap

3) Methodology

- Research design
- Participants/sample
- Instruments/data collection

- Data analysis
- Ethical approval (if applicable)

4) Results and Findings

- Main findings
- Important statistical/qualitative results
- Tables, graphs, or visuals

5) Discussion

- Interpretation of findings
- Comparison with previous studies
- Implications for nursing practice, education, or policy
- Limitations and recommendations

6) Conclusion

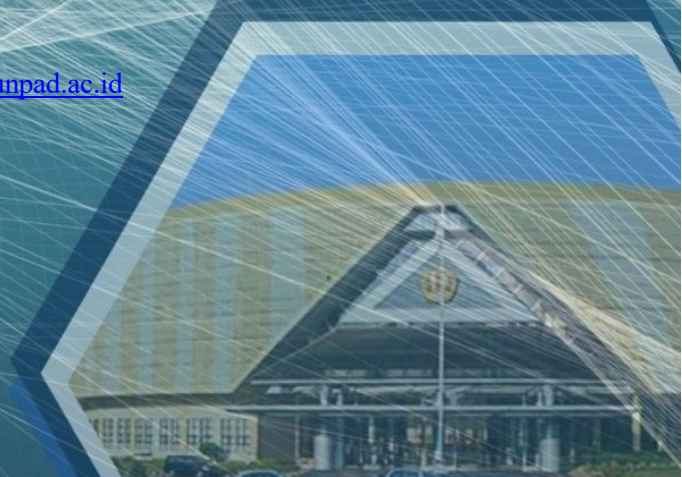
- Summary of key findings
- Contribution of the study
- Future directions/recommendation

D. Presentation Slides Requirements

1. Presentation slides must be prepared in:
 - Microsoft PowerPoint (.PPT/.PPTX) or
 - PDF format
2. Maximum:
 - 10 slides (excluding title and thank-you slides)
3. Use:
 - Clear fonts and readable text
 - High-contrast colors
 - Minimal text per slide
 - Appropriate charts, images, and diagrams
4. Ensure all visuals are clear and legible.

F. Technical Requirements

For online/hybrid presenters:

- Laptop/Desktop with webcam and microphone/headset
- Stable internet connection
- Updated browser/application
- Quiet and professional environment
- Presentation slides ready before the session starts

G. During the Presentation

1. Please join the session at least 15 minutes before the scheduled time.
2. Test your audio and screen-sharing function before the session starts.
3. Keep your camera on during the presentation and discussion session.
4. Be professional, concise, and interactive.

H. Question and Answer Session

1. A discussion/Q&A session will follow each presentation.
2. Answer questions clearly and concisely.
3. If discussion time is limited, presenters may continue communication after the session.

- Visual quality
- Time management
- Ability to answer questions

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

1. These terms and conditions apply to the poster video presentation.
2. The submitted abstract must pass the reviewer's selection process in order to be presented in the poster presentation session.
3. Presenters are required to create a poster presentation that represents the content of their abstract and manuscript.
4. The poster must be displayed in landscape format.
5. Presenters are encouraged to use pictures or narration to effectively explain their research or work. The poster should be engaging, informative, and visually appealing
6. The poster should emphasize key points and demonstrate important experimental procedures, findings, or results.
7. Please note that there may be slight changes in the conference program for any reason. Presenters are expected to be available in the meeting room or Zoom meeting from the start of the conference on the day of their presentation.
8. Each poster will be displayed for approximately 40 seconds.
9. The poster presentation will be conducted by showing a video prepared by the committee.
10. Presenters are strongly advised to keep the presentation footage within the allocated time limit. The moderator or committee representative may cut the video if it exceeds the time limit.
11. The official working language of the conference is English.
12. The poster must be submitted in PDF format with a maximum file size of 300 MB.
13. The poster size must be A4: 841 × 1189 mm.
